संस्कृत में विद्यार्थियों के पाँच गुण बताए गए हैं - काक चेष्टा, बको ध्यान, श्वान निद्रा तथैव च, अल्पहारी, गृह त्यागी विद्यार्थी पंच लक्षणम्। इसका अर्थ यह है कि एक आदर्श विद्यार्थी को एक कौए की भांति बुद्धिमान होना चाहिए, बगुले की तरह एकाग्र होना चाहिए, जिसका सारा ध्यान मात्र अपने लक्ष्य पर हो, एक कुत्ते की भांति नींद हो जो तुरंत जरूरत पड़ने पर खुल जाए, सचेत हो, अल्पहारी हो अर्थात् कम खाए, जिससे ध्यान खाने पर तथा सोने की तरफ न जाकर अपने लक्ष्य पर तथा पढ़ाई पर रहे। विद्यार्थी को गृह त्यागी भी होना चाहिए, जिसका अर्थ है कि उसे गृह तक त्यागने के लिए तैयार रहना चाहिए। वही एक सच्चा विद्यार्थी होता है।

यदि आज के प्रतिस्पर्धात्मक युग में देखा जाए, तो शिक्षा मात्र एक प्रतियोगिता बनकर रह गई है। विद्यार्थी जीवन पूर्णतः परिवर्तित हो गया है। विद्यार्थी मात्र उत्तीर्ण होने के लिए पढ़ते हैं और फिर सब भूल जाते हैं। प्राचीन युग में गुरुओं द्वारा दी गई शिक्षा शिष्यों को अंतिम साँस तक याद रहती थी।

एक विद्यार्थी के रूप में हमारे कई कर्तव्य हैं जिनमें शामिल हैं - एक विद्यार्थी के लिए सबसे महत्वपूर्ण है- 'अनुशासन' जिसके लिए उसे समय का सदुपयोग करना चाहिए। विद्यार्थी को नियमों का पालन करना चाहिए। स्वयं अनुशासन रखना चाहिए, तथा आस-पास सफ़ाई का ध्यान रखना चाहिए, बड़ों का सम्मान करना चाहिए, जो बहुत महत्वपूर्ण है। गृहकार्य समय पर करना चाहिए।

एक अच्छे विद्यार्थी के तौर पर विद्यार्थी को विद्यालयीन अंतर स्पर्धा में प्रतिभागी होना चाहिए तथा अपना मूल्यवान योगदान देना चाहिए। आज के विद्यार्थी ही कल के भविष्य हैं। एक विद्यार्थी की यह जिम्मेदारी बनती है कि वह पढ़-लिखकर, बड़ा होकर देश की प्रगति में अपना योगदान दे, उसमें सहभागी बने और अपने देश का नाम रोशन करे। विद्यार्थी के कंधों पर ही देश का भविष्य निर्भर है।

मैं एक विद्यार्थी के रूप में वह सब करने का प्रयास कर रहा हूँ, जो मुझसे हो सकता है। हालांकि हम वह सब नहीं कर पा रहे जो एक सर्वश्रेष्ठ विद्यार्थी करता है, किंतु यह हमारा कर्तव्य बनता है कि हम अपनी पूरी जी-जान लगा दें और एक आदर्श विद्यार्थी बनें।
